Because this is an indoor competition limited to 20 yards, competitors may only use long bows, recurves, or compound bows of 40 lbs. or less, and all equipment will be checked by a certified judge or representative official.

QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER TOURNAMENT:

- Archers must be members of USA Archery or members of a USAA affiliated Club
- Archers must have some experience in archery target shooting
- Only long bows, recurve bows and compound bows allowed with draw weight of 40 lbs. or less (minimum draw weight 18 lbs.)
- Target points on standard diameter shafts only •

Venue Set-up:

There will be 8 target stations with four archers assigned to each station. Two archers will shoot at a time, each at the designated target assigned to them depending on their position in the station. Maximum 32 archers to a group and maximum 3 groups. Each group will have a designated starting time. After the entry deadline, all archers will be informed of their check-in and shooting time.

LAGUNA WOODS INDOOR OPEN ARCHERY COMPETITION NOVEMBER 7, 2015

Competition Rounds:

Preliminary Elimination Round - Ten ends (three arrows each) from 20 yards

Championship Round – Ten ends (three arrows each) from 20 yards for top 32 scorers from Elimination Round

Procedures:

- 1. There will be 8 targets with four archers assigned to each target. Each archer will shoot at his/her own target. Archers will shoot in two groups and two archers will shoot at a time [shooter A will shoot at the top left target; shooter B will shoot at the top right target. After the first group of shooters (A & B) are finished, shooter C will shoot at the lower left target; shooter D will shoot at the lower right target].
- 2. Whistle commands:
 - One whistle to come to the line
 - Two whistles to commence shooting (when finished shooting step back from shooting line)
 - Three whistles to retrieve arrows (due to flooring, all archers will approach targets along the sides of the shooting field following the tape/roped safety line).
 - 2¹/₂ minutes allowed for shooting each end
- 3. If trouble with equipment occurs during an end: Raise your hand and an official will come to assist you. Arrangements will be made to complete the end at the finish of the round.
- 4. If an arrow bounces out of the target, stop shooting and raise hand to alert an official. All shooting will cease and an official will accompany shooter to replace the arrow in the target or mark it. <u>Archers will be allowed to put a mark in a hole left by arrows so that they can receive earned points when an arrow bounces out of the target.</u>
- 5. SCORECARDS MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND ACCURATELY IN ORDER FOR THE SCORE TO COUNT. CHECK AND RECHECK BEFORE TURNING IN A SCORECARD TO OFFICIALS!!!!!!!
 - Place highest score first in box, then next and so on.
 - Remember to add up number of 10s; 9s as well as total score at bottom of scorecard
 - See to it that scorers as well as shooters sign the scorecard.
